MASS. QUALIFIED TREE WARDEN COURSE **Ouestions and Answers**

This six-module course is designed to teach tree wardens what they need to know to fulfill their duties. Five sessions will be held at the Sturbridge Host Hotel in Sturbridge, MA. The sixth session will be an outdoor field day, also in Sturbridge.

What are the six dates for 2021?

What time do the classes meet? Each class will start at 8:30 a.m. and end at 3:00 p.m.

How much does it cost? One course fee covers all six sessions. Member price is \$600. Non-member price of \$685 includes a one-year membership to MTWFA.

Do I have to attend the entire course? Yes. Participants agree to sign up for and attend all six sessions.

What about lunch? Both morning coffee and lunch will be provided for the 5 sessions at the hotel. Plans will be announced for the September 29th field day.

Do I have to be my town's "official" tree warden to attend? No. We know there are many of you out there who are performing the work of a tree warden but do not have the official title. And even if you do have the title, but some or all of the actual duties are delegated to others, that's okay too. If you are a municipal employee and this course will be helpful to you, we welcome you!


Can I attend if I am not a municipal employee? Maybe. If you are not currently working for a city or town, we will place you on a wait list and notify you if space is available after August 15th.

Will there be continuing education credits? Yes. CEUs will be available for certified arborists (ISA and MCA), and there will be CTSP and pesticide credits for qualifying sessions.

Will this course be offered another time? The course is offered biennially, alternating years with UMass Green School. This means that our next Qualified Tree Warden Course will take place beginning in the fall of 2023.
