Join DCR foresters at this field workshop where you will learn to identify the signs and symptoms of an emerald ash borer infestation. Methods for EAB detection and monitoring will be covered with demonstrations of proper EAB trapping procedure.

At the workshop, green funnel traps and lure will be provided to interested town or city representatives (tree warden, conservation commission, tree committee etc.) to use for the 2019 EAB trapping season. The number of available traps is limited and priority will go to communities that have not yet had an EAB detection.

The workshop is free of charge and open to all but does require registration by 4/1/2019.
