Applicant Qualifications

Applicants must meet one of the following criteria:

- Enrolled full-time for the fall term at an accredited Massachusetts college or university in the field of Arboriculture, Community Forest Management, Urban Forestry or a related field.
- Applying to attend full-time for the fall term at an accredited Massachusetts college or university in the field of Arboriculture, Community Forest Management, Urban Forestry or a related field.
- A current resident of Massachusetts pursuing a degree full-time at an accredited out-ofstate college or university in the field of Arboriculture, Community Forest Management, Urban Forestry or a related field.

Successful college applicants who have completed the first college semester with a minimum 2.0 GPA (on a 4-point scale) will receive their award checks at the UMass Amherst Tree Conference in March 2020.

Successful applicants who are still in high school at the time of application will receive their scholarship checks upon successful completion of their first college semester with a minimum 2.0 GPA (on a 4-point scale). It is the applicant's responsibility to submit an unofficial transcript of his/her first semester grades to the Massachusetts Tree Wardens' and Foresters' Association.

- Type or print a short letter to the Scholarship Committee explaining
 - 1. Why you are interested in a scholarship.
 - 2. Include information about yourself that you think would be helpful to the committee in making our decision. Please be as explicit as possible.
